RULES AND REGULATIONS
THURSDAY EVENING



Participants in the Burnout Competition;

Participation is limited to the first 30 contestants to register!

- 18 years or older
- Vehicle Registered, Insured and Inspected in the State of Maine only
- Valid License
- Signed Liability Waiver
- 2-wheel drive only
- Safety Gear – DOT approved helmet, seatbelt required
- Long Pants
- Closed-toe shoes mandatory
- No passengers
- Secure Battery
- No Fluid Leaks
- No loose objects of any kind
 - ⇒ Officials may reject any vehicle at their discretion
 - ⇒ The competition format is one burnout run per entrant within a designated burnout box
 - ⇒ Maximum run time is 1 minute
 - ⇒ Timing begins on official signal

Judges score is based on the following;

- Smoke volume
- Vehicle Control
- Showmanship

Disqualification includes;

- Leaving the marked area
- Contact with barriers or personnel
- Failure to stop on signal
- Reckless conduct
- Evidence of alcohol or drug use

All judges' decisions are final. Event organizers reserve the right to modify rules for the safety of all or compliance.

Every participant will be required to pay for admission into the fair and must enter through the racing gate.

2nd Place

PARTICIPANT RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY, THIS DOCUMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS.

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the Topsham Fair Burnout Competition, **I agree as follows;**

1. *Assumption of Risk*

I acknowledge that participation in a burnout competition is an inherently dangerous activity involving significant risks, including but not limited to;

- Vehicle collision
- Tire explosions or mechanical failures
- Fire or explosions
- Flying debris
- Loss of vehicle control
- Serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis or death
- Damage to my vehicle or personnel property

I voluntarily assume all known and unknown risks associated with participation.

2. *Vehicle Responsibility*

I certify that:

- My vehicle is in safe operating condition with an inspection sticker
- All safety equipment required by the event has been installed and is functional
- I possess a valid driver's license
- I carry valid automobile liability insurance
- I am solely responsible for the operation, maintenance, and condition of my vehicle

3. *Release of Liability*

To the fullest extent permitted by law, I release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue;

- Topsham Board of Directors
- Event Organizers
- Sponsors
- Volunteers
- Judges
- Officials
- Property Owners
- Employees

- Agents
- Contractors (fire, EMS)
- Any affiliated organization

From all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, costs, attorney's fees, or liability arising from my participation in this event, including injury, death, or property damage, except were prohibited by law.

4. Indemnification

I agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims, lawsuits, damages, losses, or expenses arising from;

- My participation
- My vehicle
- My actions or negligence
- Claims brought by passengers, family members, spectators, or third parties resulting from my conduct

5. Rules and Safety

I agree to;

- Immediately obey all officials
- Wear all required safety equipment
- Submit my vehicle for inspection
- Stop immediately if instructed
- Not operate while under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, or any impairing substance

Failure to comply may result in immediate disqualification

6. Medical Authorization

If I become injured, I authorize emergency medical treatment, I understand I am solely responsible for all medical expenses

7. No Warranties

I understand the Topsham Fair makes no representations regarding the safety of representations regarding the safety of the course, facilities, equipment, or other participants.

8. Photo and Video Release

I grant permission for the Topsham Fair to photograph or record me and my vehicle and to use those images for promotional, advertising, or educational purposes without compensation.

9. Binding Agreement

This agreement is binding upon me, my heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, and assigns.

10. Acknowledgment

- I understand that I am giving up substantial legal rights, including the right to sue.
